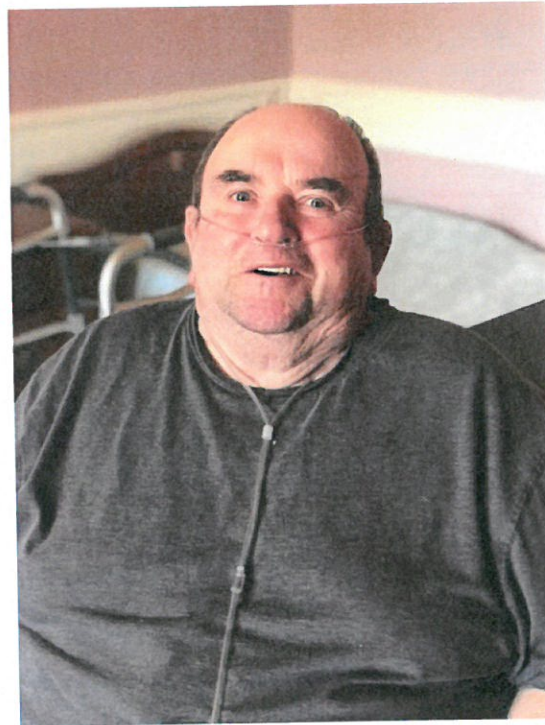
Resident of the Month - AH

Bob's kids and grandkids visit often and he always has a smile for anyone who comes in to see him.

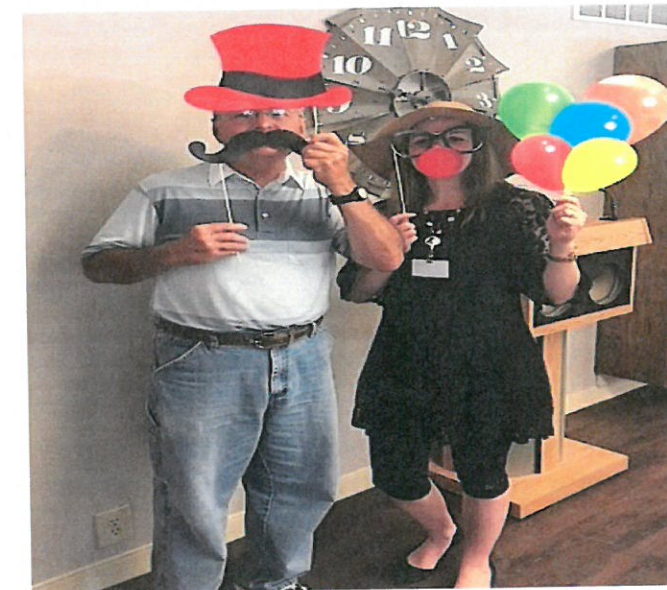
